### Pastor's Report:

- Getting things ready for VBS.

- Contemporary services will be June 8th & 15th (Cheryl will be gone)
- Will be performing a Baptism Thursday May 22nd at 10am.
- Participated in a few online classes.
- Will be gone 6/8 (synod assembly) & 7/20 (wedding in Superior).
- Put water proof covers on the outlets outside on the posts.
- Put a new sign on the Sunday School door.
- Went to the Walcott church for their closing service 4/27 and was asked to participate.

## Council Notes

### **Updates from Directors:**

#### Faith Formation & Growth:

- Kindred Kids- had their last day of lessons on May 4th. Kids also participated in the service, enjoyed a potluck, and played lots of games afterwards. During the service Pastor Kyle thanked Kelly Engstrom, Jessica Althoff, and Kari Nokleberg for leading the Sunday School team the last few years. The new Kindred Kids committee members are Candance Mattson, Jana Smith, & Kara Anderson.
- VBS- will be held May 27-29 for kids in preschool-5th grade. Registration has started.
- Confirmation-held their last class May 7th.

### **Management & Grounds:**

- Concrete fixing is needed on the east side of the church.
- Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. is working on the natural gas meters in town.
- Accel Energy quote to change the 4 furnaces in the church to natural gas is \$1,600.
- One of the four A/C units at church needs to be fixed (compressor is \$3,700) or replaced (new is \$5,950). They are old machines with hard parts to find.

Motion to buy a new unit by Justin, Seconded by Bryan, motion approved.

- CHS filled 100 gallons in our propane tank even though we asked them not to, so we'll have to get it pumped out since we're using up what we had before the natural gas changeover.
- Lumber for the new cross in the prayer garden is here, we just need time and help to get it up.

### Social Ministry & Outreach:

• Fellowship committee is getting together soon to talk about future events. They also served the potluck meal after the 5/4 service and served cake after worship on 5/18 to honor our senior graduates.

#### **Old Business:**

- Youth Director- Lanah Akvik interviewed with Pastor Kyle and Caitlin recently and we would like to offer her the position. Motion to offer her the job at \$15/hour for a maximum of 20 hours per week starting sometime after July 1st by Bryan, seconded by Sally. Motion approved.
- Directory- no new updates.
- Improvements Committee- hopefully will meet and start brainstorming ideas soon.
- Projector- the new one has arrived and the arm to hold it is coming 5/24.
- Maintenance Company- "Stein's" came and installed new liquids for the dishwasher and found things to replace on it as well.
- Shrimp Boil- had approximately 24 people attend, and the committee may try adding other options next time. They didn't have a goal for the funds, but will look into that for next time too.

#### **New Business:**

• Sunday, July 6th- we might try having an evening service that day since many people are gone over the 4th of July weekend. (Last year we only had 3 people attend the service).
